1. Archery Skills & Safety Measures
2. Wilderness Camp Skills & Outdoor Cooking
3. Compass Orienteering & Trail Navigation
4. Pellet Gun Safety & Target Shooting

Cost – The cost is \$10. The fee must be paid in advance by June 13.

A completed and signed registration form must accompany the entry fee and be dropped off at Wildside Outdoors. There are a limited number of entries and priority will be given to participants attending for the first time.

All events are at the Lloydminster Fish & Game facilities in Big Gully, 10.8 km East of Lloydminster on Hwy 303 and 2 km North on RR 3265.

Transportation and lunch are provided. Snacks and water by personal preference. Those with special diets should bring own lunch.

Transportation – Bring your child to meet the bus at 8 am at the old Lloydminster Museum/Cultural Center (4515 44 Street) parking lot. The bus will return at 4:30 pm. Parents are asked to meet the bus – bring a camera for a group photo and presentations at the Museum parking lot.

Your child needs to dress appropriately for in and outdoor activities in rough terrain.

Wearing sunscreen and bringing a hat and insect repellent is recommended. Be aware of weather – we go rain or shine.
