SASKATCHEWAN CAMP

The Lloydminster & District Fish & Game Association would like to sponsor some of our youth members, both boys and girls, to go to The **Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation Youth Conservation Camp**. The camp is at the SWF/SIAST (Hannin Creek) Education Facility at Candle Lake, SK. The camp is developed to offer young people the opportunity to learn leadership skills and experience the great outdoors. Youth experience a wide range of outdoor activities including archery, canoeing, air rifle shooting, pistol shooting, wildlife identification, plant identification, survival skills, camp cooking, fisheries studies, map & compass, GPS use and more.

ALBERTA CAMP

We will also send two students to the Alberta Zone 4 & 5 Camps at Narrow Lake.

CAMP 1 is from July 6 - 12 2025, ages 12 - 17 coed

CAMP 2 is from July 20 - 26 2025, ages 12 - 17 coed

<u>Alberta Age</u>: The Alberta camp is for both boys and girls (co-ed) who are between the ages of **12 and 17**. This camp also includes field craft and wilderness survival, archery, conservation, waterfront activities, and shooting. Certified courses offered to campers include: Alta Hunters Training, Canadian Firearm Safety, and Canadian Boating Safety.

If we have sent you before, you are still eligible to be sent and to take the advanced camp program. If selected you will need to fill out the Narrow Lake application as well. I will be submitting our selections to Narrow Lake Camp, along with our letter of recommendation.

Note: Because Lloydminster & District Fish & Game Association is affiliated with both Alberta Wildlife Federation and the Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation, any youth member (regardless of province of residence) may apply to either camp. However, they must reside within our membership area.
