All events are at the Lloydminster Fish & Game facilities in Big Gully, 10.8 km East of Lloydminster on Hwy 303 and 2 km North on RR 3265.

Transportation and lunch are provided. Snacks and water by personal preference. Those with special diets should bring their own lunch.

Transportation – Bring your child to meet the bus at 8 am at the old Lloydminster Museum/Cultural Center (4515 44 Street) parking lot. The bus will return at 4:30 pm. Parents are asked to meet the bus – bring a camera for a group photo and presentations at the Museum parking lot.

Your child needs to dress appropriately for indoor and outdoor activities in rough terrain. Wearing sunscreen, bringing a hat and insect repellent is recommended. Be aware of the weather – we go rain or shine.
